

Planned gifts also provide funding to train Salk's graduate students and postdoctoral fellows, and support state-of-the-art labs for the Institute's internationally renowned faculty, as well as lectures and symposia for the broader scientific community.

### Tax benefits

Depending on the option you choose, your **partners in research** contribution may offer immediate tax benefits or increase your income by paying you a fixed sum for the rest of your life. It may take the form of cash, securities, or real estate, or a straightforward bequest in a will or living trust. You might want to consider plans that allow you to retain an asset but give the income it generates to the **Salk Institute**. Conversely, you may choose to give the asset now but retain the income.

Inserting the following language into your estate documents is something you also may want to discuss with your attorney:


